WHAT HAPPENS ON A VERY WET SCHOOL DAY? - A

decision is made at morning tea if the day is wet as to whether or not school will close early at 2.30pm. A notice is placed on the school answerphone at 11.00am advising if it is an early finish. Notices are also placed on Radio 1XX and The Sun FM and our Facebook page. Buses always run at the normal time of 3.00pm and bus students are supervised until then. If you want your child to stay at school until 3pm they can and they will be supervised by their teacher. Please either ring the school, listen to a radio station or check Facebook for information if you think it may be an early finish. Please also discuss this with your child/children so that they know what to do on a wet day. You can imagine how difficult it is to have large numbers of children trying to ring home at 2.30pm to make arrangements with their parents. Thank you for your help with this.

Please note that not every wet day will be an early finish.

BIKES AT SCHOOL - It is great to see so many students biking to and from school. Congratulations to all those who bike safely! The bike racks are located outside the library. It is the law of the land for all students biking to wear their helmet. For your child's safety please ensure they have their helmet with them. It is also important that they bring a bike lock each day, to secure their bike to the stands. Thanks, Tai Miskell (Deputy Principal.)

<u>BUSES</u> – Many students are travelling to and from school on a bus. If anyone hasn't signed up for one of the buses they need to see Mrs Paterson and get their name down on the appropriate bus list. Bus students have also received a newsletter outlining acceptable behaviour when travelling to and from school.

ABSENCES/LATE ARRIVALS — Unless your child is ill or there are some very special circumstances, everyone is expected to attend school every day. In the case of an absence it is really important that you let the school know. Please leave a message detailing the reason for the absence e.g. sickness, funeral etc. so the correct information can be entered into the system as the Ministry of Education requires that each absence has its own special code. Please phone the office (07 308-6480) to report an absence. Absences should be reported by 9.30am as we send out text alerts if a child's name appears "unmarked" at that time. Also, any student arriving after school starts (8.50am) needs to report to the school office for a late pass.

Students may wish to bring a snack for morning interval as lunch each day will not be available until 12.30pm. Our school does not operate a canteen. We encourage families to provide water only instead of sports/juices/fizzy drinks. If you have any concerns or questions please do not hesitate to contact the office.
